Today's Divine Liturgy

Troparion for the Resurrection, in the Fifth Tone

Let us believers praise and worship the Word coeternal with the Father and the spirit born of the virgin for our salvation for He took pleasure in ascending the cross in the flesh to suffer death and to raise the dead by His Glorious Resurrection.

Troparion of the Elevation of the Holy Cross in Tone One

Save, O Lord, your people and bless Your inheritance, grant unto the faithful victory over adversaries, and by the power of Your Cross do You preserve Your commonwealth.

Troparion of Holy Resurrection Church in tone four

You have revealed the earthly majesty of the dwelling place of the holy glory, O Lord, as the brilliance of the firmament on high. Make firm its foundation unto ages of ages and receive our fervent supplications which are offered to You therein; through the intercessions of the Theotokos, O Life and Resurrection of all.

Troparion of the Archangels tone 4

Commanders of the heavenly hosts, we who are unworthy beseech you; by your prayers encompass us under the wings of your incorporeal glory, and faithfully preserve us who fall down and cry out to you; deliver us from all harm, for you are the commanders of the powers on high.

Kontakion of Holy Resurrection Church in tone four

The Church is shown to be a many-lighted heaven that does shine a guiding light upon all them that do believe; wherein while standing, we cry aloud: Do You Yourself now establish this house, O Lord.

The Epistle

Prokeimenon: Save O Lord your people and bless your inheritance. Unto you will I cry, O Lord, my God.

The reading from the Epistle of St Paul to the Galatians (6; 11)

Brethren see with what large letters I am writing to you with my own hand. It is those who want to make a good showing in the flesh that would compel you to be circumcised and only in order that they may not be persecuted for the cross of Christ. For even those who receive circumcision do not themselves keep the Law, but they desire to have you circumcised that they may glory in your flesh. But far be it from me to glory except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by which the world has been crucified to me and I to the world. For neither circumcision counts for anything, nor uncircumcision, but a new creation. Peace and mercy be upon all, who walk by this rule, upon the Israel of God. Henceforth let no man trouble me; for I bear on my body the marks of Jesus. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with your spirit, brethren. Amen.

The Gospel

The reading from the holy Gospel according to St John (3; 13-17)

The Lord said: "No one has ascended into heaven but he who descended from heaven, the Son of man who is in heaven. And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, so must the Son of man be lifted up, that whoever believes in him may have eternal life." For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. For God sent the Son into the world, not to condemn the world, but that the world might be saved through him.


