Troparion of the Resurrection, in Tone one

While the stone was sealed by the Jews, and the soldiers were guarding Your most pure body, You did arise on the third day, O Saviour, granting life to the world, for which cause the heavenly powers cried aloud unto You O Giver of Life. Glory to Your Resurrection O Christ, glory to Your Kingdom, glory to Your providence O You Who alone are the lover of mankind.

Troparion For ss. Cyrus and John in tone five

Since you have given us the miracles of your holy Martyrs, Cyrus and John, as an invincible battlement, by their entreaties scatter the counsels of the heathen, O Christ our God, and strengthen the faith of Orthodox Christians, since you alone are good and the Lover of mankind.

Troparion of the Archangels tone 4

Commanders of the heavenly hosts, we who are unworthy beseech you; by your prayers encompass us under the wings of your incorporeal glory, and faithfully preserve us who fall down and cry out to you; deliver us from all harm, for you are the commanders of the powers on high.

The Kontakion for the presentation of Our Lord tone one

O Christ our God, who by your birth made holy the virgin's womb, and blessed the arms of Simeon, as was fit, who anticipated our need, and now have come to save us, give peace to your people in their struggles, and make strong those rulers whom You have loved, O only Lover of mankind.

The Epistle

Prokeimenon; *The Lord will give strength to His people. Ascribe to the Lord, O sons of God; ascribe to the Lord honor and glory.*

The Reading from the First Epistle of St. Paul to St. Timothy. (4:9-15)

Timothy, my son, the saying is sure and worthy of full acceptance. For to this end, we toil and strive, because we have our hope set on the living God, Who is the Savior of all men, especially of those who believe. Command and teach these things. Let no one despise your youth but set the believers an example in speech and conduct, in love, in faith, in purity. Until I come, attend to the public reading of scripture, to preaching, to teaching. Do not neglect the gift you have, which was given you by prophetic utterance when the council of elders laid their hands upon you. Practice these duties; devote yourself to them, so that all may see your progress.

The reading from the holy Gospel according to St. Luke (19:1-10)

At that time, 1 Jesus entered Jericho and was passing through. 2 And there was a man named Zacchaeus; he was a chief tax collector, and rich. 3 And he sought to see who Jesus was, but could not, on account of the crowd, because he was small of stature. 4 So he ran on ahead and climbed up into a sycamore tree to see Jesus, for he was to pass that way. 5 And when Jesus came to the place, he looked up and said to him, "Zacchaeus make haste and come down; for I must stay at your house today." 6 So he made haste and came down and received him joyfully. 7 And when they saw it they all murmured, "He has gone in to be the guest of a man who is a sinner." 8 And Zacchaeus stood and said to the Lord, "Behold, Lord, the half of my goods I give to the poor; and if I have defrauded any one of anything, I restore it fourfold." 9 And Jesus said to him, "Today salvation has come to this house, since he also is a son of Abraham. 10 For the Son of man came to seek and to save the lost."

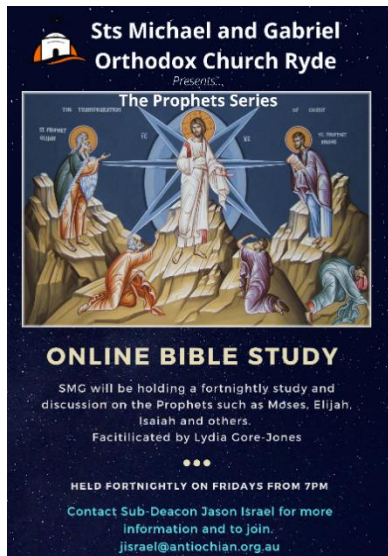

Church School



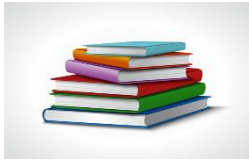
SMG Church School lessons are held in the parish house after Divine Liturgy during school term. All students are encouraged and welcome to join the children's choir.
